Godaita Municipality intends to procure ambulance as listed below under the catalogue shopping procedure as described in public procurement act 2063. All eligible manufactures or authorized dealers are invited to submit sealed proposal with their catalogue containing technical, specification, prices and services within 15 days of first publication date during office hours. The manufactures or authorized dealers must submit copy of firm registration certificate, copy of Vat/Pan registration/tax clearance certificate for F/Y: 2077/78 and the letter of authorization along with the application. If the deadline falls on holiday the deadline will be extended next day till office hours. Godaita Municipality invites sealed bids under the following terms and condition from eligible bidders.

- 1. Eligible manufactures or authorized dealers may obtain further information and inspect the bidding document at Office of Municipal Executive, godaita, Sarlahi.
- 2. A complete set of bidding document may be downloaded from the office of Municipal Executive, godaita,sarlahi's website: www.godaitamun.gov.np
- 3. Interested Authorized distributors may submit their proposal along with company registration certificate, Vat/Pan registration/tax clearance certificate of 2077/78 along with authorized specification/Rate with detail catalogue and Authorization certificate to the office of Municipal executive, godaita, sarlahi on of before 12:00:00 on January 26, 2022. Proposal received after this deadline will be rejected. Proposal will be opened in the presence of bidder's who choose to attend at office of Municipal executive, godaita, sarlahi.
- 4. Proposal shall be opened at office of Municipal Executive on January 26, 2022 at 13:00 hrs.
- 5. Bank guarantee issued by any finance company in any firm will not be accepted.
- 6. In the case of discrepancies or error in bid documents, bid notice or any other documents, Office of Municipal executive, godaita, sarlahi reserves the right to amend or correct at any time.
- 7. The purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject the bids without assigning reason whatsoever.
- 8. Matter not by covered by this notice shall be accordance with bidding document, public monitoring act 2063, public procurement regulation 2064 and other relavent laws of government of Nepal.

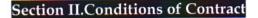

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Section I. Invitation for the Procurement through Catalogue Shopping Method

- Godaita Municipality, Office of The Municipal Executive, Godaita, Sarlahi, invites Proposals for the Supply, Delivery, Testing and Commissioning of Ambulance as detailed in attached Specifications and the Schedule of Requirements provided herein.
- 2. The Proposals submitted by the Bidder shall comprise the following:
 - a) Quotation and Price Schedules
 - b) Schedule of Requirements
 - c) Technical Specifications
 - d) Catalogue
- Proposals must be submitted to Office of Municipal Executive, Godaita, Sarlahi on or before 12:00:00 on January 26, 2022.
- 4. Proposals shall be Opened at Office of Municipal Executive on January 26, 2022 at 13:00 Hrs.
- 5. The Bidder shall indicate on the Price Schedule the unit prices (where applicable) and total price of the goods to be supplied under the contract. All duties, taxes and other levies payable by the Producers/Authorized Distributors under the contract shall be included in the rates, prices and total Bid Price submitted by the Bidder.
- 6. Price quoted by the Bidder shall remain fixed and valid until completion of the Contract Performance and will not be subject to variation in any account.
- 7. Submitted Proposals must remain valid for a period of 15 days after the deadline for submission date.
- 8. The Bidder shall furnish, as part of its bid, documents establishing the Supplier's/Bidder's eligibility to bid and qualification to perform the contract if the bid is accepted. Documents to establish such eligibility shall be but not limited to the following:
- a) Up to date Firm/Company Registration Certificate
- b) VAT and PAN Registration Certificates
- c) Tax Clearance Certificate of FY 2077/0778
- d) Manufacturer's Authorization Certificate
- e) Other documents as needed
- 9. The goods supplied under this contract shall confirm to the Schedule of Requirements and the standards mentioned in the Technical Specification.
- 10. If the last date of purchasing, submission and opening falls on a government holiday then the next working day shall be considered the last day.
- 11. The Purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject the Proposal without assigning any reason, whatsoever.



1. Definitions

1.1. In this contract, the following terms shall be interpreted as indicated:

- a) "The Contract" means the agreement entered into between the Purchaser and the Supplier, as recorded in the Contract Form Signed by the parties, including all attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein.
- b) "The Contract Price" means the price payable to the Supplier under the contract for the full and proper performance of its contractual obligation;
- c) "The Goods" means Equipment and related Accessories and spare-parts or any other materials which the Supplier is required to supply to the Purchaser under the contract;
- d) "Services" means services ancillary to the supply of the goods such as transportation and insurance including the installation, commissioning and the operational and maintenance training of the supplied equipment.
- e) "The Purchaser" means the procuring entity purchasing the goods.
- f) "The Supplier" means the organization supplying the goods and services under this contract.

2. Procurement Process

- 2.1. Invitation for Proposal: The Purchaser will invite proposal from eligible firms openly for the procurement.
- 2.2. Evaluation of Proposal/Brocher/Catalogue: The proposal submitted by bidder will be evaluated from Nepal Engineering Council registered Mechanical Engineer for responsiveness of proposal from bidder.
- 2.3. The purchaser will ask supplier for financial proposal on Detail Price, discount on it and addition of any extra service along with supply.
- 2.4. After receiving financial proposal, the purchaser will evaluate it and select lowest evaluated substantially responsive bidder according to Public Procurement Regulation rule 31b(5).
- 2.5. The lowest evaluated substantially responsive bidder will be asked for contract agreement for the supply.
- 2.6. Upon supply of Performance Security one month more than warranty period according to Public Procurement Regulation rule 110(4) in the form of Bank Guarantee or Cash Deposit in Century Commercial Bank, Godaita Branch Dharauti Khata 0130000016GE in the name of supplier.

3. Technical Specification

3.1. The goods supplied under this contract shall confirm to the standards mentioned in the Technical Specification.

4. Patent Right

4.1. The Supplier shall indemnify the Purchaser against all third-party claims of infringement of patent, trademark or industrial design rights arising from use of goods or any part thereof in the Purchaser's country.

5. Inspection and Tests

5.1 The Purchaser or its Representative shall have the right to inspect and/or test the goods to confirm their conformity to the Technical Specification and the quality of performance

after the supply and delivery of good to the Purchaser's premises.

6. Packing

6.1 The Supplier shall provide such packing of the goods as is required to prevent their damage or deterioration during transmit to their final destination as indicated in the contract.

6.2 The packing shall be sufficient to withstand, without limitation, rough 'handling during transit and exposure to extreme temperatures, salt and precipitation during transit and open storage.

6.3 The packing, marking and documentation within and outside the packages shall comply strictly with such special requirements as shall be expressly provided in accordance with international standard and practice.

7. Delivery of Goods

7.1 Delivery of the goods shall be made by the Supplier in accordance with the terms specified by the Purchaser in its Schedule of Requirements.

8.Warranty

- 8.1 The Supplier warrants that all the goods supplied under the contract shall fully comply with the specification laid down in the contract.
- 8.2 The warranty shall remain valid for one year after the goods have been delivered to the final destination indicated in the contract, and accepted by the Purchaser after installation and commissioning of equipment by the Supplier.
- 8.3 The Purchaser shall promptly notify the Supplier in writing of any claims arising under this warranty.
- 8.4 Upon receipt of such notice, the Supplier shall, with all reasonable speed, replace the defective goods without cost to the Purchaser. The Supplier will be entitled to remove, at its **own** risk and cost, the defective goods.

9. Payment

9.1 Payment of the goods supplied shall be made in Nepali Rupees as per decision of Municipal Executive regarding Procurement of Medical Vehicle

10. Prices

10.1 Prices charged by the Supplier for goods delivered under the contract shall not vary from the prices quoted by the Supplier in its Proposals.

11. Insurance

The Purchaser will be responsible for taking out any appropriate insurance coverage.

12. Governing Language

12.1 The Governing Language shall be: Nepali or English

13. Applicable Law

13.1 The applicable law shall be Laws of Nepal.

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14. Notices

14.1 Purchaser's address for notice purposes: Godaita Municipality Godaita, Sarlah

14.2 Supplier's address for notice purposes:

15. Taxes and Duties

15.1 The Supplier shall be entirely responsible for all taxes, duties, license fees and other such levies imposed by the GoN.

16. Operation, Maintenance and Spare-parts Manuals

16.1 The successful Supplier shall supply 2 copies of manufacturer's operation, maintenance and spare-part manuals of the goods (Equipment).

17. Conduct of Suppliers

17.1 The Supplier shall be responsible to fulfil his obligations as per the requirement of the Contract Agreement, Bidding documents, GoN's Procurement Act and Regulations.

- 17.2 The Supplier shall not carry out or cause to carry out the following acts with an intention to influence the implementation of the procurement process or the procurement agreement:
 - a. gives or propose improper inducement directly or indirectly,
 - b. distortion or misrepresentation of facts
 - c. engaging or being involved in corrupt or fraudulent practice
 - d. interference in participation of other prospective bidders.
 - e. coercion or threatening directly or indirectly to impair or harm, any party or the property of the party involved in the procurement proceedings,
 - f. collusive practice among bidders before or after submission of bids for distribution of works among bidders or fixing artificial/uncompetitive bid price with an intention to deprive the Purchaser the benefit of open competitive bid price.
 - g. contacting the Purchaser with an intention to influence the Purchaser with regards to the bid or interference of any kind in examination and evaluation of the bids during the period after opening of bids up to the notification of award of contract

18.Blacklisting Supplier

- 18.1 The GoN, Public Procurement and Monitoring Office (PPMO) & BM may blacklist a Supplier for his conduct up to three years on the following grounds and seriousness of the act committed by the supplier:
 - a. if it is proved that the supplier committed acts pursuant to the Sub clause 16.2,
 - b. if it is proved later that the supplier had committed substantial defect in implementation of the contract or had not substantially fulfilled his obligations under the contract or the completed work is not of the specified quality as per the contract,
 - c. if convicted by a court of law in a criminal offence which disqualifies the supplier from participating in the contract.
- 18.2 Supplier declared blacklisted and ineligible by the GON shall be ineligible to bid for a contract during the period of time determined by PPMO.

19. Dispute Resolution

19.1 Any dispute arising out of the Contract, which cannot be amicably settled between the parties, shall be referred to adjudication.

Section III.Schedule of Requirements
